Avid golfers will enjoy a PGA Tour Golf experience at The Tournament Players Club (TPC) of Scottsdale Stadium Course. The course is located adjacent to The Fairmont Scottsdale Princess. Designed by the team of Tom Weiskopf and Jay Morrish, the course has its own unique qualities and offers guests a choice of challenge.

The Stadium Course is the home of the annual PGA TOUR FBR Open (formerly the Phoenix Open). Lush fairways surrounded by desert vegetation and breathtaking mountain views enhance the golf experience on this 18 hole, par 71 course. One of the most dramatic holes on the TPC Stadium Course is the 15th hole. It is a reachable par-5 with water surrounding an island green. With bunkers in the front of the green and a lake to the left it creates an interesting challenge for all.


